The independent nature of the Kangal dog can make them challenging in obedience
training. Working dogs can occasionally take 2 to 3 years to reach maturity.
1. We require a commitment to attend at least 1 group training classes with your dog (private lessons are an option). What training facility do you plan to use? (Name and phone number.)
